Killarney is on the north shore of Georgian Bay.



Getting to Killarney

By Car - From Toronto, take Hwy 400 North to Hwy 69 then take 637 West to Killarney. It is a 4.5 hour ride. From Sault Ste. Marie via Hwy 17, 69 South, and 637 West. From Ottawa via Hwy 17 to Sudbury, then south on Hwy 69 to the turnoff at Hwy 637. Turn right on Hwy 637 and travel to Killarney.

By Commercial Airline - Air Canada to Sudbury.
(Car rentals available at Sudbury Airport).

By Taxi - Consult with your Killarney hosts to make arrangements for taxi transfer from the Sudbury bus station or airport. Standard taxi fares apply.
